In addition, there was a collection box where employees could make






donations to Lisa's favorite charity, the Humane Society.



Molson Coors Awards Brand Rights to Inco for Fever-Tree



Molson Coors recently awarded Inco Beverage the distribution rights for **Fever Tree**, a line of premium carbonated mixers designed to complement alcoholic spirits. Founded in the U.K. in 2004, the company is driven by a desire to create high-quality tonic water free from artificial ingredients.

Fever-Tree offers a diverse range of mixers, including various tonic waters, ginger beer,

ginger ale, club soda, Sicilian lemonade, and flavored sodas. All products are crafted with naturally-sourched ingredients, without artificial sweeteners, and are designed to enhance both cocktails and non-alcoholic beverages.

Molson Coors, which owns an 8.5% stake in Fever-Tree, has granted Inco the rights to deliver Fever-Tree across our entire Miller-Coors footprint, with the exception of the small section of eastern Allegheny County where we deliver the Miller family of brands.

Here's some more exciting brand news: Inco Beverage has been given the distribution rights for Little Kings Cream Ale. It's a distinctive American beer with a rich history rooted in Cincinnati, OH. Introduced in 1958, it was initially crafted as a celebratory drink for patrons of Cincinnati's Montgomery Inn. Its unique 7-oz. green bottle and smooth, slightly sweet flavor quickly garnered a dedicated following. Inco will be delivering this great new addition to our portfolio in Westmoreland, Fayette, Washington, Indiana, Cambria, Somerset, Blair, Bedford, Clearfield, Centre, Greene, and Huntington counties.
